Experience of discrimination

Non-LGBTI+ youth



Nearly **half** of **non-LGBTI+ youth** regularly felt **unfairly treated**



LGBTI+ youth

Nearly three quarters of LGBTI+ youth regularly felt unfairly treated

Treated with less courtesy or respect than others 62%



Treated with less courtesy or respect than others 74% (p \leq 0.000)

Treated as if you were **not as smart 49%**



Treated as if you were **not as smart** 60% (p \leq 0.002)

Minority stress: social context



As we have always said, Bert and Ernie are best friends. They were created to teach preschoolers that people can be good friends with those who are very different from themselves. Even though they are identified as male characters and possess many human traits and characteristics (as most Sessing Street Mucrost M de), they remain puppets, and do not have a sexual orientation.



Minority stress: legacy of colonisation

Sexual orientation

1885: Criminal Law Amendment Act

- Introduced in **54** countries
- Protect from 'corruption'
- **Correct** 'native' custom
