### Cohort '98 @ 25 years



- Data collection @ 25 in progress
- Mixed mode CAPI with self-complete / full CAWI
- First time parents not surveyed
- Challenging age cohort
- Emigration
- Response Rates & Strong CAWI response



## Cohort '98 – Topics covered



- CAPI/CAWI
- Housing & household
- Health
- Labour market
- Income
- Emigration
  - Short question set for those living abroad

- CAWI/self-complete
- Emotional well-being
- Relationships
- Identity
- Risk taking
- Interactions with the justice system



## Cohort '98 @ 25 years – coming up



- Data collection closes Q1 2024
- Preliminary analysis & data file preparation
- Administrative data analysis Value & Burden
- Headline results, AMF, RMF due Q4 2024



## Cohort '24 – getting started



- New birth cohort from 2024
  - Cohort 24 will be recruited at 9 months old
  - Data collection at same intervals as Cohort 08 for comparability between cohorts
    - 9 months, 3, 5, 7, 9, 13.....
  - Identify key administrative datasets
  - Main data collection schedule for end Q3 2024
  - Pilot survey currently in the field



#### Cohort '24 - Pilot

- Pilot survey
  - Specifications from DCEDIY
  - 680 children born in Q1 2023
  - Testing questionnaires and field procedures
  - Respondents
    - Primary informant reporting on baby and household
    - Parent(s)/caregiver(s) resident with baby on self/relationships
    - Parent resident elsewhere on self/relationships
    - Childcare provider (8+ hours per week) on activities, environment





#### Cohort '24 – Field work update

- 2 coordinators & 17 interviewers
- Field work 8 weeks 16/10 to 09/12
- Gathering Feedback
- Focus Group
- Engage with DCEDIY Q1 2024



#### Cohort '08 - Pilot

- Currently between waves next collection @ 17 years in 2025
- Pilot survey @ 17 years Sept-Nov 2024
- 200 cases in pilot
- Strong focus on education pathways
  - Post-school choices
  - Experience of second level education
  - Early school leavers
  - Use of administrative educational data
- Wide range of other topics
  - Health behaviours, mental health, substance use, relationship with technology and social media, caring responsibilities, civic participation, employment goals
